Dental Assistant Certificate—Canton Campus only

The dental assistant is an important member of the dental team. Effective utilization of a well-trained dental assistant results in more effective dental service for a greater number of people with less time and productivity expended by the dentist.

Medical Assisting Certificate—Canton Campus only

This one-year (full-time) program offers quality training. Graduates are eligible to participate in the National Certified Medical Assistant Examination.

Nurse Education—Brockton Campus only—Full-time Days

This two-year program, which is accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission and approved by the Massachusetts Board of Registration in Nursing, prepares its graduates for a variety of rewarding careers in the field of nursing. Upon successful completion of the program, the graduate is awarded an Associate in Science degree and is eligible to take the NCLEX-RN examination to become licensed as a registered nurse.

Nurse Education—Brockton Campus only—Part-time Evening

- 1. Generic Program—This nursing option is a part-time generic program lasting three years. Nursing I-E, Nursing II-E, and Nursing III-E are equivalent to Nursing I, II, and III of the day nursing program. Nursing A, B, and C are equivalent to Nursing IV and V of the day program. The program is designed to mirror the day program yet provide a longer period of time for students to reach their educational goals.***
- 2. LPN to RN Program—LPNs admitted to this program will be given credit for Nursing I, II, and III (16 credits). LPNs coming from Blue Hills Regional Technical High School, Southeastern Regional technical High School, and Bristol Plymouth Technical High School will also receive credit for Human Growth and Development.***

Radiologic Technology—Brockton Campus only

The Radiologic Technology Program is a 21-month program that is designed to prepare students for careers as entry-level radiographic technologists. Upon completion of this program, the graduate is eligible to apply for examination by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists. The skills developed in the program will prepare the graduating student to perform imaging examinations and radiologic procedures under the direction of a physician.

Respiratory Care—Brockton Campus only

Respiratory Care is a two-year Associate Degree program, which is accredited by the National Board for Respiratory Care. Upon successful completion, the graduate is eligible to take the national Board for Respiratory Care Examinations. Graduates wishing to continue their education can earn a Bachelor's Degree.

Phlebotomy—Canton Campus only

Phlebotomists are specially trained professional members of the healthcare delivery team, whose primary responsibility is to collect blood specimens from patients for diagnostic testing. Upon completion of the program, students are eligible to sit for the Phlebotomy Technician Examination offered by the American Society of Clinical pathology (ASCP).
